Robin Class Newsletter - Week Beginning 7th - 11th February 2022

In literacy the children began the week sequencing the animals in the order that Tammy meets them. They then created wonderful story text maps to match the story of Tammy meeting the Arctic animals. The children have now learnt the final part of the story and next week will have a go at re-writing the end of the story. It will be great to see how the children are now able to apply their phonics knowledge to their writing.

In maths the children worked hard to compare numbers using manipulatives to help them build numbers to compare. Using the symbols of greater than, less than and equals to the children are able to compare numbers to 20.

In phase 5 we have been reviewing all their learning for the half-term. The children applied their new phonics knowledge by playing games like match the picture and phoneme. The children created dance moves to match their learning on sounds that have different graphemes but sound the same. Next week the children will continue to review their Spring 1 phonics but this time they will practice writing their new graphemes in words and sentences.

In science the children learnt all about how animals adapt in the Arctic. The children focused on the polar bear and were able to label a diagram showing how a polar bear adapts to the freezing cold Arctic weather.

The children finished the week making some beautiful hearts and crafting them with jewels and mosaic tiles.
