Robin Class Newsletter - Week Beginning 22nd - 26th November 2021

The children began the week enjoying our second stop in our 'Jolly Postman' journey travelling to the wicked witches house. The children received a letter from Hobgoblin Supplies to tell that they had been invited to work for them as fairy tale accessories designers. The children's first job was to design a new product for the wicked witch. The children came up with some wonderful designs like rainbow broomsticks that played disco music and cauldron's that have buttons to press that magic the exact ingredients that any witch would need to make her potions. They were then told that a buyer for Hobgoblin Supplies would be coming to visit them and they had to pitch their designs to them. The children used some wonderful persuasive language to sell their designs.

We continued with rehearsals for our nativity. The children have learnt three of the songs. I was so impressed with their fantastic singing and enthusiasm. We have allocated all the parts for the nativity and letters will be sent home on Monday telling you which part your child has. There will also be instructions for what costumes will need to be provided. All the narrators will be sent home with their lines to practice so please practice these with your children.

In maths we are looking at subtraction within 10. The children have learnt how to work out subtraction number sentences using the crossing out method. The children worked through all their maths rainbow challenges and some of the children attempted subtraction number sentences within 20.

In phonics we are continuing to review our phase 3 sounds. This week we also began looking at phase 4. In phase 4 we looked at longer words and how to chunk them in the correct way before we read our graphemes. The children continue to work hard at their sentence reading. The tricky words we learnt this week were: what, when, he, she, we, be, me, have and love. The children were able to identify all the tricky parts of the word and worked hard to learn how to spell the tricky words correctly.
