The children began the week enjoying our third stop in our 'Jolly Postman' journey and this time we travelled to the giant's house from Jack and the Beanstalk. The children began by looking at postcards from all around the world and learnt how to familiarise themselves with the key features of postcards. The story of Jack and the Beanstalk was read to the children and they completed some story maps and writing activities so that they were familiar with the story. We then arrived at the giant's house to find a postcard written from Jack to the giant. The children got to ask questions to the giant about how he felt about receiving the postcard from Jack and played a game of debate tennis to decide if they would forgive Jack for all the things he did to him. The children finished the week off by writing their own postcard back to Jack as the giant telling him what they thought of his postcard and if they could forgive him.

In maths we are still looking at subtraction within 10. The children have learnt how to work out subtraction number sentences using number lines. Next week the children will be having their end of unit test so please have a look at the KIRF's on the website for Autumn 1 and 2 and go over the learning for these.

In phase 4 we continued to look at longer words. The children continue to work hard at their sentence reading. The tricky words we learnt this week were: was, they, some, come, were, there, sure and pure. As some of the children were absent we will be having our tricky word test for both last week and this week together at the end of this week. Words to learn for this week are: said, says, you, do, like, little, push, pull, put and full. Next week the children will begin phase 5.
