In maths we learnt all about 2D and 3D shapes. The children went on shape hunt all around the school and then made their own 2D and 3D shapes out of natural materials during forest school.

In phase 5 we are learning all about graphemes that sound like the other graphemes we have learnt. This week the focus was on 'ie', 'ir', 'u' and 'ue'.
