## Robin Class Newsletter - Week Beginning 24<sup>th</sup> January -28<sup>th</sup> January 2022

The children began the week by learning about how to use adjectives in their writing. The children wrote some wonderful sentences describing Tammy from Tammy went to the Arctic. On Wednesday we began to turn our story about Tammy going to the Arctic into a story text map using Talk for Writing. The children worked hard on re-creating their story text maps and learning the new text and actions. Next week they will have a go at re-writing the story.

In maths the children consolidated their learning from last week and we began our learning on tens and ones to twenty. The children worked hard on building tens numbers and identifying how many tens and ones were in the numbers they made. In our maths meeting we learnt the days of the week using the Adam's family theme tune and the children loved learning the song.

In art the children learnt all about the Aurora Borealis. The children studied pictures of the Northern Lights and looked at the colours that were made. Then using coloured chalk and black paper they re-created the pictures they had been looking at and learnt how to look at different shapes that were made. They learnt how to rub the chalk to create the different colours and shapes.

In phase 5 we are learning all about split-digraphs. We have started with split-digraphs that have a silent 'e' at the end of words. We have been learning a-e, i-e, o-e and u-e. We have been doing some tricky word reviews and looked at my, by, sure and pure. Please keep learning these at home.

In PSHE we continued to learn about what bullying means and what we could do if we were being bullied.
