Hi Everyone,

We have completed another half term and are nearly half way through the year! Time goes so fast!

So far this term we travelled to the Arctic and Antarctic and looked at which animals live in each place as part of our 'Out of this World' topic. The children have also learnt that the Arctic is at the North Pole (top of the world) and the Antarctic is at the South Pole (bottom of the world). We have learnt some facts about penguins and what we would need to pack if we were going to be an explorer. The children have also investigated how to make a boat that could carry a penguin to the South Pole by exploring waterproof materials, floating and sinking and freezing and melting in our Science lessons. The children designed and built their own boat and tested them to see if they would float.

We have now started our next Out of this World destination, Space! We have read the story Aliens Love Underpants and designed our own pants and written about them. When we return we will continue this story and begin to learn about the planets in our solar system.

In Phonics we have nearly finished Phase 3, which are some of the trigraphs and digraphs that the children will come across. We will be continuing to practise these on our return after half term. I have sent home some 'homework' for the children to practise over the half term if they have time.

In Maths we have finished numbers 1-5 and are now progressing to number to 10.
