



It was lovely to welcome the children back into school for their last half term in Wren Class. Eeeeeeeek! Where has the time gone?! I hope you all had a lovely half term break and enjoyed the Jubilee celebrations.

This week we have started a mini topic, Minibeasts. We are starting by looking at worms and how important they are in the environment. During Forest School the children made a Wormery and we have put it in our classroom to observe the changes that happen to the soil. The children enjoyed making the wormery and collecting worms to live in it. Next week we will be reading the story Superworm and leaning all about different types of worm.

During our Literacy lesson the children wrote a postcard and drew a picture, showing what they did during the half term holiday. The children have really progressed in their writing ability during the spring term.

The children enjoyed watching a theatre company who came into school to perform a play about helping to keep your mental health, healthy. It was very funny and the children really enjoyed it!

During our Maths lessons we have been learning about odd and even numbers. We have also practised doubling and subtraction within 5. These are part of the Early Learning Goal and it would be useful if you could practise these with your children at home.

During Phonics we have continued with Phase 4 which is reading longer words and reading words with adjacent consonants. We also practised tricky words, there, when, what and one.

Our PE lesson this week was a mixture of activities! The children practised a relay race with a baton. Practised hitting a tennis ball from the top of a cone with a racket and practised catching a small ball.

During RE the children built houses out of different construction materials and talked about different homes from around the world. This term the theme is Special Places.

Next week we will be turning the role play area into Ascot Tea Tent! The children will be going to wave at the Queen and enjoy a cake and drink at the real tea tent, on Thursday. If you can help with looking after the children from 1:30pm until 14:30pm, please let the office know in advance.
