



This week in our Literacy lessons we have been reading the story 'Supertato'. The children have really enjoyed this story and made their own potato head. The children had some amazing design ideas such as creating a mouth that could turn either happy or sad and used their skills to use tools such as scissors for cutting cloaks, etc., and cocktail sticks to secure items onto the potato.



The children wrote about their potatoes and also had a go at making an 'evil pea' warning poster!

During our Phonics lessons, we continued Phase 4 of our Little Wandle Letters and Sounds programme. The children have learnt some more tricky words which will be going into their book bags this week, some, come, love, do, said, so, have, like.

During our Maths lesson, the children have been learning to double numbers 1-5. They practised rolling a dice and working out what the double was. They also practised doubling in Mrs Harvey's shop.

During our PE sessions the children have been practising their athletics skills on the running track ready for Sports Day.

In Forest School this week the children made shelters which came in handy as it kept raining on and off! They also decorated bunting by bashing leaves and

flowers onto the material with a hammer. The material is left with a lovely imprint of the leaf or flower.



During our science lesson we talked about keeping safe and healthy and why it is important to wash our hands properly, especially before eating. We used three slices of bread and used one piece to wipe on the computer table, one piece to touch with unwashed hands and one piece to touch with washed hands. We then waited a few days and checked which piece of bread grew the most germs (mould). The Computer Table was by far the most dirty item!

On Wednesday next week, the children will be making a fruit salad, so please could they bring into school on Wednesday, some items of their favourite fruit (or slices). They will be practising chopping up the fruit so please leave the items whole or if they are large items such as melon, please send in a slice. Please could you add this to the Whatsapp group.
