



During Forest School this week, the children talked about the weather that we had experienced recently. We talked about the storm and how windy it had been. The children had the opportunity to make windmills and windsocks as well as exploring the forest.

During our Phonics lessons, we have been practising reading longer words such as 'laptop' and 'carpark'. Next week we will be assessing the children and will revise any sounds that the children need to practise.

We have been learning about the Solar System this week and have learnt the names of the planets and some information about them. The children are really enjoying our Space Topic and we are impressed at the knowledge they are sharing with each other. The children had a go at writing a sentence about their favourite planet.

In our handwriting lessons, we practised writing the capital letters O and P.

During Maths, the children have been learning all about the number 8. They have practised making 8 using 2 different numbers and visited Mrs Harvey's shop to practise one more and one less, addition and subtraction.

The children have continued to practise gymnastics in PE, which included balancing on beams, climbing on the wall bars, jumping from a height and rolling along mats. During our PHSE lesson, the children shared how they keep healthy by exercising. It was lovely to see the children's photos and videos of the activities that they do outside of school.
