During our Phonics lessons this week, we practised words ending with 's' and listening to see which words ended with a 's' sound or a 'z' sound. We also learnt tricky words 'we', 'me' and 'be'.

Our Literacy lessons were based around the story 'The Great Explorer' and the children chose a picture of their favourite part of the story to write about. The children also learnt about some of the animals found in the Arctic and made a fact poster.

In our handwriting lessons, we practised writing the capital letter E & F.

During Maths the children continued practising subtraction and one less using a 5 or 10 frame. They also learnt about zero and what it means.

Mrs Higgins set up a gymnastics course again in PE, which included balancing on beams, climbing on the wall bars, jumping from a height and rolling along mats.

The children made some lovely Northern Lights chalk pictures in our Art lesson and practised the skill of blending chalk with their fingers.
