During our Phonics lessons this week, we have been learning the sounds 'ff', 'll', 'ss' and 'j', along with tricky words 'put', 'pull', 'full' and 'as'. The children have learnt the meaning of the word 'digraph', two letters that make one sound. The children have practised writing and reading words containing these sounds. We haven't been able to read with as many children this week due to our Christmas play rehearsals but we will be back to our normal routine after our performance on Tuesday.

This week in Forest School, the children enjoyed exploring the beautiful snow covered forest. They found lots of ice and footprints!

On Tuesday, the children had their PE lesson with Mrs Higgins. They continued to practise their catching and throwing skills and also how to do a relay race.

During our Literacy lesson this week the children brought in a teddy that was either old or new. We compared the teddies and the children wrote a word or a mini sentence about their bears.

The children had their RE lesson with Mrs Spong and learnt about the shepherds and their role in the Nativity story.

During our Maths lessons this week, we explored number 4. The children practised different ways to make 4, one more and one less and revised their knowledge of squares and rectangles.

Our Christmas play rehearsals are going well and the children have been practising in the hall on the stage. We are hoping to film the play on Tuesday morning.
