



Wren Class Newsletter - Week Beginning 15/11/2021.

A wonderful autumnal week in Wren Class!

During our Phonics lessons this week, we have been learning the sounds 'f', 'l', 'h' and 'b', along with tricky words 'I' and 'the'. We will be putting these tricky words into the children's reading pack this week. Please could you continue to show them to the children and ask them to say the word. You could hide them in the house e.g., near their toothbrush or on their pillow, etc. Next week we will be assessing the children as we have finished our first set of sounds so we will spend the week revising what we have learnt so far and putting it into practice.

This week in Forest School the children were learning about the different types of trees in the forest and the shape of their leaves. There are lots of leaves in the forest at the moment and the children enjoyed making piles of leaves and jumping into them. The children made some lovely leaf creatures and leaf masks.

On Tuesday the children had their PE lesson with Mrs Higgins. They continued moving to music and extended their dance from last week. Mrs Higgins mentioned how good the children were at following her instructions and engaging with the lesson.

During our Literacy lessons this week we read the story 'Don't Hog the Hedge' and learnt about hedgehogs and animals that hibernate. The children drew a picture of an animal that hibernates and practiced writing words by using the phonic sounds that they have learnt.

The children had their RE lesson with Mrs Spong and have been learning about 'giving' and why we buy presents for each other.

During our Maths lessons this week we have been learning what is one more and one less than a number up to 6. The children played a bus game where passengers got on and off the bus and also made picture using circles and triangles.

During our PHSE lesson the children talked about how they can keep themselves and others safe. We made a class poster with all our ideas.

Thank you for all your Children in Need contributions. The children looked wonderful in their spotty accessories and each child was given a raffle ticket for the Pudsey Bear raffle. The draw was made during the Head Teacher's assembly on Friday.
