



## Wren Class Newsletter - Week Beginning 08/11/2021.

Another busy week at school!

During our Phonics lessons this week, we have been learning the sounds 'ck', our first digraph (two graphemes that make one sound), 'e', 'u' and 'r'. The children are progressing well in their phonics lessons and we are hoping to have all children reading simple books by Christmas.

The children enjoyed their Forest School session this week and had a go at making poppies in addition to exploring the forest.

On Tuesday the children had their first PE lesson with Mrs Higgins. They had their lesson in the hall and practiced their movement skills by dancing and acting to a circus theme.

During our Literacy lessons this week we read the story Leaf Man and created our own leaf creatures. The children designed their creature using different shapes leaves and then attempted to write words using their phonic knowledge. All the children had a go at writing even if it was one letter.

On Wednesday the children learnt about Remembrance Day and why we mark this occasion. We read the poem In Flanders Field by John McCrae and read the book Where the Poppies Now Grow. The children made lots of poppies to decorate the classroom and also made a poppy for their buddy in Year 6.

On Thursday we learnt all about number 3 and different ways to make 3. We also talked about a triangle and how many corners it has.

During our PHSE lesson the children talked about their rights and what is important to them in their life. They came up with some lovely 'rights' of their own such as 'being cared for by their parents' and 'being kind to each other'.
