This week in Forest School, the children explored the allotment. Mrs Miles showed the children the different herbs and vegetables that were growing there. They also had a go at finding different pictures of birds hidden around the school grounds.

During our Literacy lesson, the children listened to the story 'Stick Man'. All the children completed an activity, making a picture of their family members using sticks and leaves. We will be displaying some of the pictures on the display board outside our classroom.
