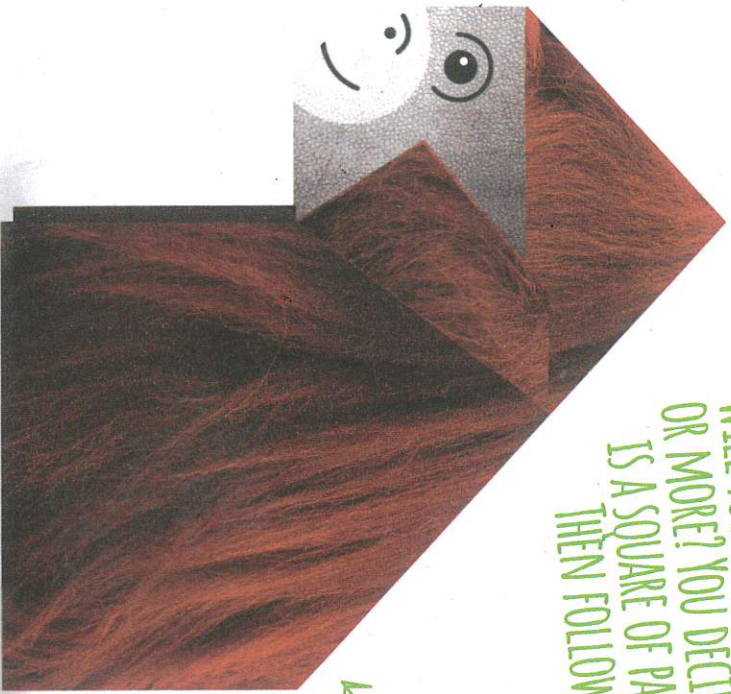


# MAKE YOUR OWN HOME FOR ORANGUTANS

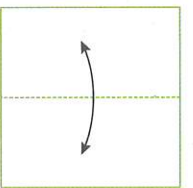
By being part of our team you're helping to protect orangutans and support their long-term survival. You're helping us protect their habitat, so they can thrive.

WILL YOU MAKE ONE ORANGUTAN - OR MORE? YOU DECIDE. ALL YOU NEED IS A SQUARE OF PAPER AND A PEN. THEN FOLLOW THE STEPS...

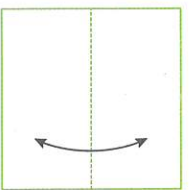

With the orange side of your paper down (if you've coloured it in first), fold the left edge over to meet the right edge, and unfold.

Fold the top edge down to the bottom edge.

Fold the left edge to the crease in the middle of your paper, and unfold.

4



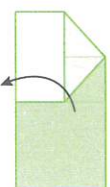
Fold the top left corner down along the dotted line shown. Give it a good creasing, and unfold.

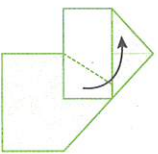
Now push the top left corner towards the inside of the two halves of your paper. Let the half of the paper nearest you open out as shown in the circle, to start making your orangutan's head.

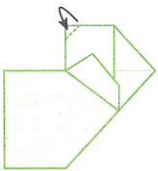
Fold the whole right side of your paper down behind where the head will be. Then, press the left side of your paper into the shape shown.

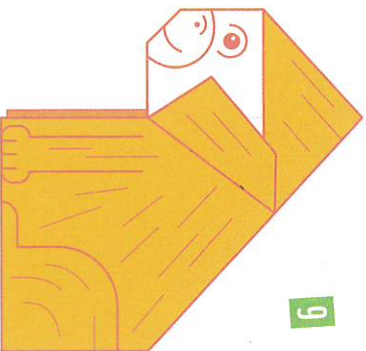
Fold the bottom right corner of your gorilla's head up, on the dotted line.

Fold the tip of the bottom left corner back.

Give your orangutan some eyes, a nose and mouth - maybe a bit like this. Now put it in the landscape that came with your pack!

TOP TIP: COLOUR ONE SIDE OF YOUR PAPER WITH LONG ORANGE 'HAIRY' LINES BEFORE YOU START
