

MAKE YOUR OWN HOME FOR MARINE TURTLES






Fold the bottom left corner of your paper up to the top right corner, and unfold.

2




Fold the top left corner down, creasing it in about the same place as the dotted lines shown.

Fold the bottom of your paper up so that it's folded in half.

Turn your paper round so that the longest edge is on the bottom.

Your turtle should look like this.

Fold both sides of the paper at the bottom of your turtle upwards and outwards on either side.

Your turtle should now look like this. Now you can get creative and give your turtle some eyes and draw some patterns on its shell.

To add some flippers, you'll need a pair of scissors (ask an adult for help if you need it). Make two careful cuts on each side, on the dotted lines.

Fold both the two back flippers outwards on either side. Now put your turtle in the ocean scene that came with your pack!
