The children thoroughly enjoyed our Arctic launch day on Tuesday. It was great fun pretending to be on the airplane and exploring the Arctic!

During our Literacy lesson, we investigated different types of animals that live in the Arctic and learnt some facts about them. The children made posters about the animals by drawing them and attempting to write words and sentences.

It has been our phonics assessment week this week, so instead of our normal phonics lessons we have been playing games and revising some of the previously learnt sounds. All the children have made progress since our last assessment in the Autumn Term. Next week we will be starting 'Phase 3' digraphs such as 'ai', 'ee', 'igh', 'oa' and 'oo'.

In our Maths lessons, we have practised one more and one less within 5. The children practised by singing songs such as 'Five Green Bottles' and 'Five Currant Buns' as well as purchasing items in Mrs Harvey's shop.

In Forest School this week, the children learnt about birds and had a look to see if they could find different types of bird hiding in the Forest!

The children enjoyed a Music lesson with Mrs Roberts this week and listened to and joined in with some traditional Chinese Music, in preparation for learning about Chinese New Year next week.

In our PHSE lesson we talked about how we can stand up for ourselves if someone is unkind to us.

Lastly, the children enjoyed a reading session with their Y6 buddies. It has been great that we can now see them again at lunch time and short sessions within the week.

Next week we are learning about the Antarctic and making a boat for a penguin!
