



## Wren Class Newsletter - W/B 28/11/2022.

We have finished our rehearsals and are ready to perform our Christmas Play next week! Hurray! We will be performing to the school on Monday afternoon and to our families on Tuesday afternoon.

During our Literacy lessons, the children have read the story 'Winter Sleep'. The story is about a boy who visits his Grandma and she takes him to a secret forest, where they learn all about animals that hibernate. The children drew a picture and wrote about their favourite hibernating animal.

During our Phonics lessons, we have learnt the phonemes, 'w', 'y', 'v', 'x'. Our tricky/high frequency words this week were 'and', 'has', 'her' and 'his'. Please double check the pronunciation of 'w' and 'y' on our Wren Class page or the Little Wandle website as the pure sound may be different to what you expect.

In our Maths lessons, we have looked positional language and using full sentences to describe where something is placed. We tried to use language such as 'in-between', 'behind', 'through', etc.

The children are thoroughly enjoying their PE Lessons with Mrs Higgins and have progressed onto using the gym equipment. The children have been amazing at listening and following instructions so that they can use the equipment safely. Please have a look at Tapestry to see what they have been up to.

During our RE lessons the children have been learning about the Christmas story and we will be looking at this in more depth during the last few weeks of term.
