



## Wren Class Newsletter - W/B 14/11/2022 & 21/11/2022.

Apologies for two weeks Newsletters in one. It has been a busy two weeks!

During our Literacy lessons, the children have read the stories 'Owl Babies' and 'Don't Hog the Hedge'. Our writing has been based around nocturnal animals and hibernating animals. The children drew pictures of an owl and wrote a fact about it, and wrote some facts about hedgehogs. The children's writing is really progressing and all the children are willing to have a go.

During our Phonics lessons, we spent a week revising the phonemes that we had learnt so far and assessing the children and this week we have learnt the phonemes, 'ff', 'll', 'ss', 'j'. Our tricky words this week are 'put', 'pull', 'full' and 'as'. I will pop these into the children's reading packs next week.

In our Maths lessons, we have looked at the properties of 2D shapes, circle and triangle and one more and one less within 3. The children practised one more and one less in Mrs Harvey's shop as some prices had reduced by 1p and some had increased by 1p!

The children are thoroughly enjoying their PE Lessons with Mrs Higgins and have progressed onto using the gym equipment. The children have been amazing at listening and following instructions so that can use the equipment safely. Please have a look at Tapestry to see what they have been up to.

We have been practising our songs for the Christmas play and are now starting to practise the Angels, Shepherds and Snowflake dances. Next week we will practise the whole play so please continue to practise any lines that your children have. Thank you!

During our RE lessons the children have been learning about 'giving' and being 'thankful'. We talked about what present would make us happy and things that we are thankful for. Our Jigsaw (PHSE) lessons this term are about celebrating

difference, and we have talked about how we are all different to one another and that his is OK.

Next week we will reading a story called 'Winter Sleep' and looking at other tpyes of animals that hibernate.
