



Wren Class Newsletter - Week Beginning 07/11/2022.

We have had a very busy week this week!

During our Literacy lessons, the children talked about their experiences of Bonfire Night. We talked about what we could see, hear, smell, taste and touch. The children had a go at smelling pots containing items such as hot chocolate, toffee apple, burnt wood, etc and then drew a picture of something from Bonfire Night. The children practised writing their name and having a go at writing letters or simple words.

During our Phonics lessons, we have learnt some new sounds, b,f,h and l, along with tricky word 'the'.

In our Maths lessons this week, the children learnt about representing number 3 and subitising, (knowing how many without counting), numbers 1,2 and 3. The children also visited Mrs Harvey's shop where they practised buying items for 1p,2p and 3p using 3 x 1p coins.

We talked about Remembrance and made a lovely poppy display to show to the rest of the school at our Remembrance Assembly. The children also learnt about Remembrance during their Forest School session and made a poppy out of leaves.

Mrs Roberts visited the children and showed the children a Glockenspiel and a Xylophone. The children all had a turn at playing the instruments.

The children thoroughly enjoyed their first PE Lesson with Mrs Higgins and practised beanbag skills and running/movement games.

We have started practising our songs for the Christmas Play! I will be sending the lyrics home with the children so that they can practise with you at home.

During our RE lesson this week the children learnt about Moses and the Ten Commandments and in our Jigsaw (PHSE) lesson the children talked about what they were good at and how each person is different from everyone else.
