



## Wren Class Newsletter - Week Beginning 31/10/2022.

The children settled back into school after the half term and had lots to tell us about the half term holidays and their Halloween adventures.

Our book of the week this week was 'Leaf Man.' The children listened to the story during our Literacy lesson and made their own leaf creature. The children are making good progress in writing their name and starting to write simple words or initial sounds in words.

During our Phonics lessons, we have had a 'fun phonics' revision week. The children listened to funny monster rhymes and listened carefully to see if they could hear the initial sounds and match them to the correct letter. We also practised writing simple words by segmenting and listening to the sounds within words.

In our Maths lessons this week, the children learnt about representing number 1 and 2. They practised drawing the numbers, looking for representations of 1 and 2 in pictures and drawing their own representations.

We discussed Autumn and what happens in this season. The children made a tree picture using their fingertips to decorate it with Autumn coloured leaves. This will be the front cover of their Topic Book for this term.

Mrs Roberts visited the children and taught an Autumn themed music lesson. The children sang some Julia Donaldson songs and then made 'rain' using bells, inspired by Vivaldi's Four Seasons.

Lastly, we started practising the songs for our Christmas play and held our auditions. I will be sending out the song words and what part the children will be performing next week.

Next week the children will be exploring their senses and talking about Bonfire Night.

Please note that it will be Forest School on Monday morning and the children's first PE lesson on Tuesday morning with Mrs Higgins. Please could the children

wear their PE kit to school. They will be wearing this all day and do not need to bring any school uniform to change into.
