



Wren Class Newsletter - Week Beginning 10/10/2021.

This week in Forest School, the children read the story Stick Man. The children enjoyed exploring the forest and made campfires together demonstrating how to carry long sticks safely. They examined different types of leaves and made some stick people using clay, sticks and leaves that they found in the forest.

During our Phonics lessons, the children have learnt to pronounce the 'pure' sounds for the phonemes g,o,c,k. We have also practised writing the corresponding graphemes or letters. I will enclose a paper copy of next week's sounds in the children's Reading Pack on Monday. The children have really enjoyed watching 'Geraldine Giraffe' on Youtube. They find her very funny!

During our Literacy lesson, we read Stick Man again and the children made lovely pictures of their own 'stick' family using the leaves and twigs that they had collected. They practised writing their name and also the names of their family members. I have taken photographs of the pictures to stick into the children's Topic Book and they can take their 'originals' home next week.

In our Maths lessons this week, the children learnt about measurement. Specifically, using the correct language such as more & fewer, tall & short, long & shorter, etc. Most children use 'big & small' to describe different sizes of objects so it is good to practise the correct mathematical language.

In our Religious Education lesson, the children learnt about Jesus and, how he was a role model to Christians. They listened to, and watched a story about Jesus healing a paralyzed man and discussed if they thought Jesus was special or not.

The children have been doing lots of singing this week in preparation for our Harvest Festival at the church next week and also enjoyed a mini music lesson with Mrs Roberts in the classroom. They sang some lovely 'movement' songs and had a go at playing an African drum.

On Friday after our Jigsaw PHSE lesson on 'kind hands', the children met up with their Year 6 Buddies and made a 'kind hand' together.

Next week the children will be, reading 'The Gruffalo' and creating their own terrible creatures!
