



## Wren Class Newsletter - Week Beginning 03/10/2021.

We have had such an exciting few days this week!

This week in Forest School, the children went on a bear hunt! Mrs Miles and Mrs Spong had set up areas in the forest to match the story. After listening to the story with their own teddy, the children had a lovely time stepping through, mud, water and a snowstorm! The children and their teddies enjoyed a picnic of fruit and hot chocolate too.

During our Phonics lessons, the children have learnt to pronounce the 'pure' sounds for the phonemes i,n,m,d. We have also practised writing the corresponding graphemes or letters. At the end of our Phonics lesson we play a game to practice listening to words that are 'sound talked' and blending them in our head, into words. For example; Can you touch your h-e-d, head! I have added some 'homework' onto our class page showing you the sounds we have been learning and some games to practise with your child at home. I will also enclose a paper copy in the children's Reading Pack.

During our Literacy lesson, the children practiced writing their name, sequencing the story and attempting to write their first words & letters on maps that they created. Some children were able to write the word 'map' independently!

In our Maths lessons this week, the children had a go at sorting and matching. They practised sorting buttons into different groups and matching pairs of socks and shapes.

In our Religious Education lesson, the children discussed who might be a role model. We looked at different role models in our society and around the world and the children drew a picture of their own role model. We had some lovely ideas from Policemen to our own Mum or Dad.

On Friday the children met up with their Year 6 Buddies and practiced singing some of our Harvest Festival songs and playing on the Adventure Trail together.
