Transfer to Secondary/ Middle/Upper School – September 2023

Parents of children wishing to apply for a school place for September 2023 must submit an application between 9 September 2022 and 31 October 2022. If you are not resident of the Royal Borough of Windsor & Maidenhead, please contact your local authority for further information on how to make your application.

If you are a resident of the Royal Borough of Windsor & Maidenhead please apply online on the [Royal Borough of Windsor and Maidenhead website](http://www.rbwm.gov.uk). There is a link on option 2 of the School Admissions webpage (*Applying for a Secondary, Middle or Upper school*) which will redirect you to the application portal. The page also includes a User's Guide for using the portal.

You will need to register for an account on the ONE Citizens Portal before making your application. The portal supports mobile devices, as well as PCs and laptops. Please make a note of the email address and password you use to register.

You do not need a UID (Unique Identifier) to make your application. Please select the option to continue without it.

Guidance on entry testing for admission to state-funded selective schools during the coronavirus outbreak

The Royal Borough of Windsor and Maidenhead School Admissions team is unable to provide information about grammar school testing arrangements and dates etc. Please contact the relevant local authority for information.

Parents must apply for their child's secondary school place no later than the closing date i.e. 31 October 2022. Both grammar schools and non-selective schools must be included within the six preferences allowed in an application in the event that the child does not meet the required standard for entry into a grammar school. Parents are encouraged to look at the allocation information published on The Royal Borough website to make an informed decision about the non-selective schools they choose to name as a preference and the likelihood of their child being allocated a place at the school based on the oversubscription criteria.

Further information on how to decide preference order and equal preference processing will be provided in the Admission into Secondary School September 2023 guide which will be published no later than 12 September 2022.
