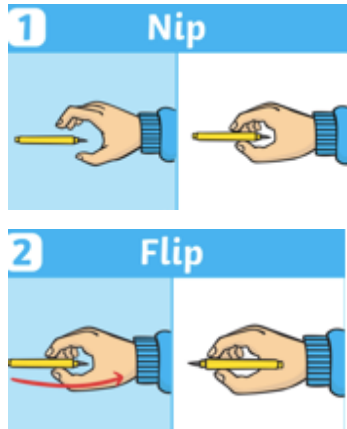


Wrens Home Learning – Autumn 1

Writing

Practise holding your pencil correctly – nip, flip, grip!

What is your favourite dinosaur? Can you draw it and ask an adult to help you write some facts about it.

Can you pack your own

school bag? Practise opening the flap and putting in your jumper and colouring pages. Can you use your strong fingers to open and close the fasteners?

RE

Think about who is special to you and why. Make them a you are special card.



Physical

Can you practise your ball skills? Practise catching and throwing a large ball such as a football. Can you bounce the ball on the ground and catch it? How many times can you do this without dropping it?



Art

Have a look outside your window or when you next go into your garden or go for a walk. Can you see the beautiful Autumn colours as the leaves change from green? Using a coloured pencil or crayon, practise making different shades of each colour. Press harder to make the shade darker and more lightly to make the shade lighter. How many different shades can you make?

Maths

Can you practise **sorting**? You can sort socks, clothes, shoes, toys, fruit, beads, etc. How will you sort them? By colour? By shape? You decide!



Can you make **sets**?

Can you make sure three of your Teddies all have exactly the same set of different objects. E.g. they all have a bowl, spoon and cup or a banana, apple and orange.
