This week we launched our new topic, 'The Jolly Postman'. We will be in the world of, 'The Jolly Postman' for the next four weeks. This week the children received a surprise parcel addressed to them from the Jolly Postman. Inside the parcel was a letter from the Jolly Postman and some clues about the story. The children used their inference skills to investigate the letter and make predictions on the character of the Jolly Postman, his life and who he delivers letters to.

The theme of the Post Office was continued into the Continuous Provision. I built a Post Office for the children to play in. Each day the role of the postman, post worker and cashier is assigned and the children deepen their topic learning through play. At the end of each day the post box is emptied by the postman and the letters, postcards or cards are delivered. This has been a wonderful opportunity for the children to practice their writing.

The children are still learning phase four phonics. On Monday the children will be tested on the first Autumn half-term tricky words.
