Mrs Harvey and Miss Offord might also be helping you.



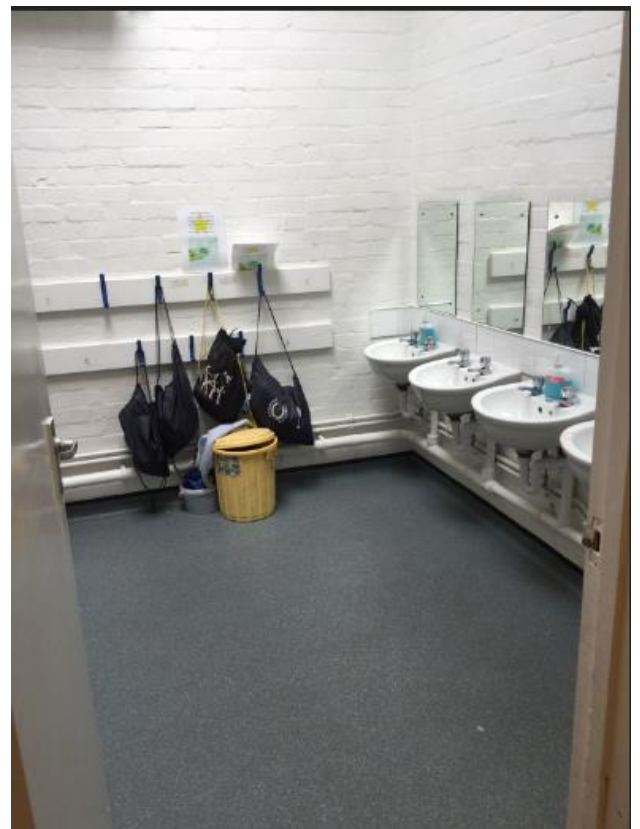
They might be in your classroom and will help you play and learn.

Mrs Summers will also be helping you and taking you to Forest School!



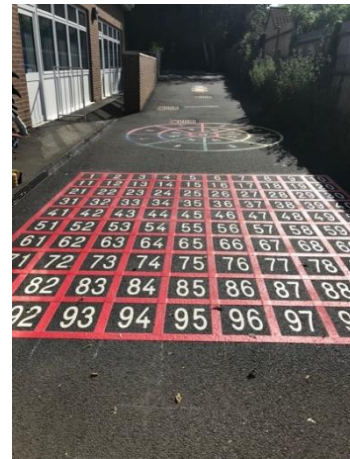
At Forest school you can play and learn outside with your friends.

You can choose what you want for lunch each day.

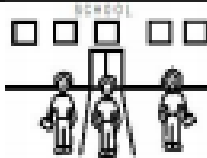

- Leave home



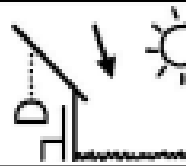

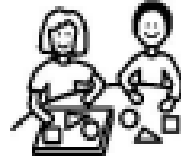
