



Wren Class Newsletter - Week Beginning 17/05/2021.

This week the children learnt all about the Islamic celebration, Eid. A few of the children in the class had celebrated Eid with their family and shared with the class their experience, photos and information. The children learnt about why Eid is celebrated and watched videos showing children preparing and celebrating Eid.

In our phonics lessons, we revised 'ow', 'oi' and 'ur' as well as practising tricky words and finding them in books. We are finding that the children know the sound when it's shown to them in isolation but are unable to recognise it when it is contained within a word. An idea that could be tried at home is when you are reading a story to your child ask them to pick out words with certain Phase 3 sounds or Tricky Words. See if they can find any!

During our Literacy lesson we had a look at our sunflower seeds and noted how they had grown. The children used magnifying glasses to look at the root and shoot in detail before drawing a picture and writing a sentence about it. The children have now take their sunflower home ready for planting. Please send us a photo on Tapestry if any of them flower before the end of term.

The children had a look at the newts in the pond during Forest School and searched for mini beasts. During PE the children had a go a relay races to warm up and then played the pirate game.

During Maths we have continued learning about 'teen' numbers and that they are ten and some more. The children learnt about number 20 and practised counting on from a given number when adding two numbers together.
