



## Wren Class Newsletter - Week Beginning 10/05/2021.

The children have had lots of fun this week!

In our phonics lessons, we revised 'oo', ar and 'or' and practise reading and writing words containing these sounds. We are finding that the children know the sound when it is presented to them in isolation but are unable to recognise it when it is contained within a word. An idea that could be tried at home is when you are reading a story to your child ask them to pick out words with certain Phase 3 sounds or Tricky Words. See if they can find any!

During our Literacy lesson we had a visitor who spent the morning watching the children. He was Mr Gingerbread Man! When the children returned from lunch, they discovered that he had gone missing. A part of his leg had been left on the shelf and a pile of crumbs left by the Rainbow Gate. The children had lots of ideas as to what might have happened to him! We decided to make 'wanted' posters and stick them up around the school, in case anyone saw him. Mrs Harvey found a letter the next day addressed to Wren Class and you won't believe who it was from. You guessed it. Mr Gingerbread Man had written a letter and a map with clues so that the children could find him! The children really enjoyed this story and did some lovely writing on their posters.

The children had a lovely time in Forest School this week and enjoyed their PE lesson. Although it was a little bit wet!

During Maths we have continued learning about 'teen' numbers and that they are ten and some more. The children learnt about number 14 and 19 this week and we also practised 'doubling'.

The children listened to a Sikh story about treating people equally, called 'The Crocodile and the Priest' and we had a look at our sunflower seeds to check if they had grown. The children drew a picture and wrote a sentence about the changed to the seed.
