



Wren Class Newsletter - Week Beginning 19/04/2021.

Welcome back! The children have been superb at settling back into the class routine! Please find below a summary of this past week in school.

In our phonics lessons, we revised 'ng' and played games to practise reading and writing words containing this sound. We also had a Phonics Fun Friday on the playground and played a version of 'What's the Time Mr Wolf', practising tricky words and the phase 3 sounds that we have revised so far.

During our Literacy lesson, the children had a go at writing a postcard independently, about what they did during the Easter holiday.

In Forest School, the children made wild flower bombs, played parachute games and helped to weed and water the plants in the allotment.

During Maths we have been learning about 3D shapes and their properties. The children could choose to go on a 3D shape hunt around the school, make cube boxes, cuboid money boxes, sphere and cone ice-creams, cylinder telescopes and cone party hats and lots more!

In our Religious Education lesson the children listened to the story 'The Boy Who Cried Wolf' and we chatted about why it is important to tell the truth. This term we are looking at what we can learn from fables from around the world.

In handwriting, we practised the capital letter K and in our art we looked at the work of Picasso and how he used shapes in his paintings.

For the first time, Wren Class were introduced to the whole school in person during our Head Teachers Assembly. It was great to see all the children in the school sat in their bubbles on the playground in the sunshine, signing a song together.

Next week are going to be reading the story 'Jack and the Beanstalk' and planting a sunflower seed to observe the changes that happen as it grows. We will also have our first PE lesson on Monday!
