



Wren Class Newsletter - Week Beginning 29/03/2021.

We hope you all had a happy Easter and are enjoying the school holidays! Here is a summary of the things that Wren Class got up to during the last week of term.

In our phonics lessons, we revised 'th' and played games to practise reading and writing words containing these sounds. We also had a go at a Phase 3 Word Hunt in our outdoor area.

During our morning lessons, we learnt about Spring, Easter and the Easter Story. The children enjoyed listening to the Easter story and asked lots of questions about Jesus and what happened to him. They made some lovely Easter cards and wrote in them and some of the children made books about the Easter story!

In Forest School, the children checked for changes to the frog spawn in the pond and discovered that tadpoles had now hatched. The children also made an Easter Garden. They all looked beautiful!

We had a very special end of term assembly on the playground. This is the first time that Wren Class have sat together (well 2 metres apart!) with other classes from the school. Our assembly was with KS1 and the children were fantastic at sitting and listening to Mrs Searle. It brought a tear to my eye when we all joined in with singing a song led by Mrs Roberts. The first time we have all sang together for over a year!

When we return we will spend the first week settling back into school and writing a postcard about what we did over the Easter holidays. We will ask the children to draw a picture and attempt to write a sentence by themselves so that we can see what we need to focus on for the Summer Term in regards to writing independently. Many of the children know the sounds that they want to write but need confidence to have a go without adult support. Any independent writing practise that they can do at home would be great! For example, writing a list of items that they would like you to get from the shop, etc.
