



## Wren Class Newsletter - Week Beginning 22/03/2021.

This week we celebrated World Down Syndrome Day. The children were invited to wear crazy socks for the day. The children learnt about how we are all different and that we all enjoy different things, look different, have different opinions and learn things at different speeds and times. We then had a look at our crazy socks that we had worn.

During our phonics lessons, we revised 'ch' and 'sh' and played games to practise reading and writing words containing these sounds.

In Literacy, we read the story 'Dragon Post', about a boy who finds a baby dragon in a cupboard at home. He decides to write to various people who he thinks can help him look after the dragon and receives replies via letters in the post. Some of the children chose to have a go at writing a letter or postcard and received a reply back!

In Forest School, the children learnt about signs of Spring and checked for changes to the frog spawn in the pond as well as having a go at finding pictures of Easter eggs hidden in the forest.

During our Maths lessons we practised making 10 and the different ways we can do this. We also practised making repeating patterns.

Next week our focus will be learning about the Easter story.
