



## Wren Class Newsletter - Week Beginning 15/03/2021.

We have had another lovely week in Wren Class. The children especially enjoyed Red Nose Day on Friday. We started the day explaining why we have Red Nose Day and watched a video about a boy who had benefited from one of the many charities Comic Relief supports. The children then designed their own red nose and wrote a sentence about it using 'tricky word' my. In the afternoon, we had a nose and spoon race in our house teams. The children loved this and were shouting support for their team mates. It was great to see them supporting each other.

During our phonics lessons, we learnt the last sound in Phase 3, 'er' and spent the rest of the week practising Phase 3 Tricky Words. Please continue to practise these at home with the children. Next week we will begin revising Phase 3 and practise writing and reading words containing the Phase 3 sounds.

In Literacy this week, we read the story Cinderella. The children have written a sentence about a magical picture as part of our writing assessment.

In Forest School, the children made some clay birds and had a look at some frog spawn that Mrs Harvey brought from home to put into the pond at school. We learnt about the life cycle of a frog in the classroom and made a pretend pond in our outdoor area.

In Maths this week we practised counting back from 10-1 and subtracting 1 by singing the song '10 in the bed' and practising more and fewer.

Next week our focus will be dragons! We will be reading the story 'Dragon Post' and 'Zog'.
