



Wren Class Newsletter - Week Beginning 09/11/2020.

Another lovely week in Wren's Class!

During our Literacy lesson we read the story 'We're Going on a Bear Hunt'. The children completed lots of activities including sequencing the story and having a go at writing initial sounds or simple words and making a picture of their favourite part of the story. During Forest School the children enjoyed a bear hunt, splashing through water, mud, grass, etc. They had a great time!

In our phonics lessons this week we have been learning about the letter 'o', 'c' and 'k'. The children have practised making the 'pure' sound for these letters and thinking of objects that begin with each sound. We have practised writing the letters in cursive letter formation and watched 'Geraldine the Giraffe' on Youtube. In our Friday phonics lesson, we had a go at blending letters together. We used 'robot' talk to sound out each word and the children had to see if they could find the matching picture and letters to spell the word. We also practised reading and writing tricky words 'and'.

In Maths this week, we learnt all about number 2. The children practised finding two each of an object, matching pairs of socks, completing repeating patterns using two stamps, decorating a number 2 with two of everything and visiting Mrs Harvey's shop to spend 1p and 2p coins. All the children made amazing pictures all about number 2 based on the book Anno's Counting Book.

During the afternoons the children have completed handwriting and dough disco lessons, practising the letter 'm' and 'n', practising their 'thinking skills', having a go at 'Mat Man' and learning about Diwali and Children in Need.

We hope that you are enjoying a lovely weekend despite the weather and look forward to seeing you on Monday.
