Welcome to the first Wren Class Newsletter!

Each week we will post a newsletter onto the Wren Class 2020 page of the school website which will inform you of the learning that has taken place that week and any information or messages.

Firstly, it has been a pleasure to meet you and the children and we hope that the children have enjoyed their first few days at Cheapside School.

We have been busy getting to know the children and making them feel at home in the Wren classroom. Myself, Mrs Harvey, Mrs Bailey and Miss Guest have been setting up activities so that we can observe the children playing and complete the baseline assessment. This will take several weeks to complete and will help us with our planning to develop the children further.

The children have been amazing at settling in and today completed their first piece of 'work'! We have been reading the story 'Harry and the Dinosaurs go to School' and the children discussed what favourite toy they would put in their bucket. The children drew some lovely pictures and had a go at writing their name on their finished work. The children put a photo of themselves onto our rainbow after completing this challenge and added a sticker to their rainbow challenge chart. Once they receive five stickers they can choose a prize from the rainbow challenge prize box.

The children have quickly started to learn the routines in the classroom and the rules around staying in our class bubble to keep safe. From next week, please walk your child through the main gate and onto the playground where I will be

waiting to greet them. I can collect any lunch orders and messages from you and the children can independently walk down the steps to the classroom. Please follow the blue arrows to exit the school via the main gate.

A few of you have asked when PE will be. We won't be doing PE until the Spring term and I will advise nearer the time when that will be. Forest School will start on Tuesday 6th October and children should come into school wearing their Forest School clothes and trainers and bring in a pair of wellies that will remain in school.

Next week we will be reading 'The Colour Monster Goes to School' and discussing our feelings. Please could you email to the school office or add a photo to Tapestry of your child as a baby as we will be paying a guess who game the following week when we start our 'All About Me' week.

We hope that you have enjoyed looking at the Tapestry observations and don't forget to upload any 'wow' moments that your child has at home!

Finally, a reminder that the children will be starting school full time next week, blue group on Monday and Tuesday and yellow group on Thursday and Friday, unless there is a prior arrangement in place. The children should arrive at 850am- and can be collected at the main gate at 310pm.
