the week.



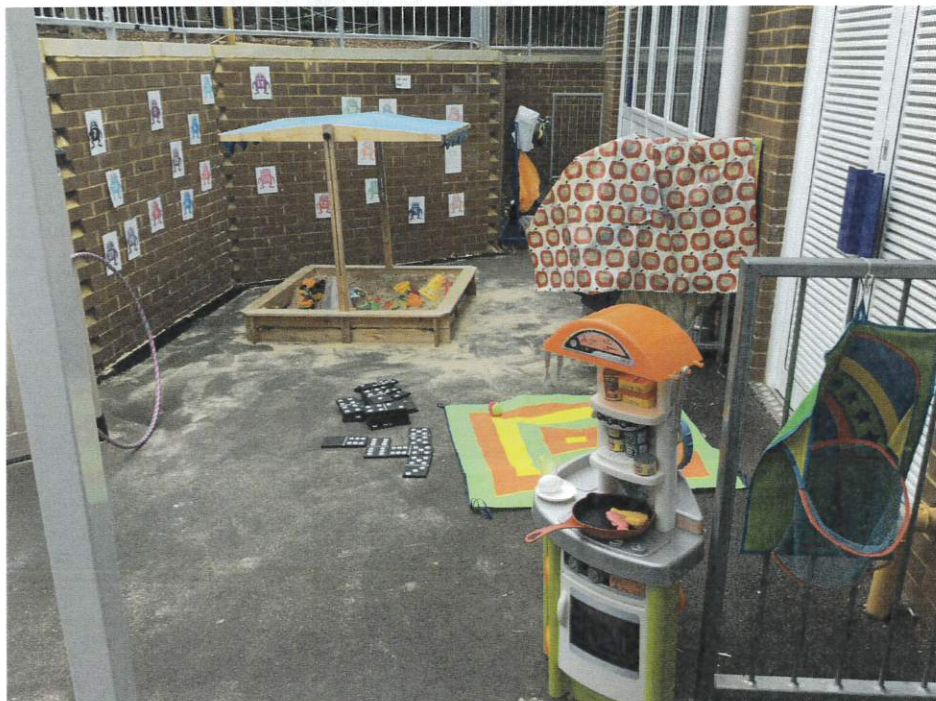
This is my classroom

There is also an outdoor area where I can play when I have done my work.

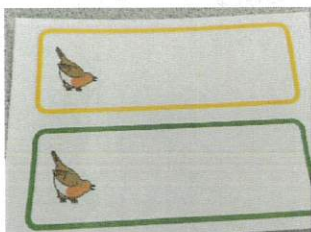


Mrs Miles will be taking me to Forest School in the Spring Term.

I will still eat my lunch in the hall.

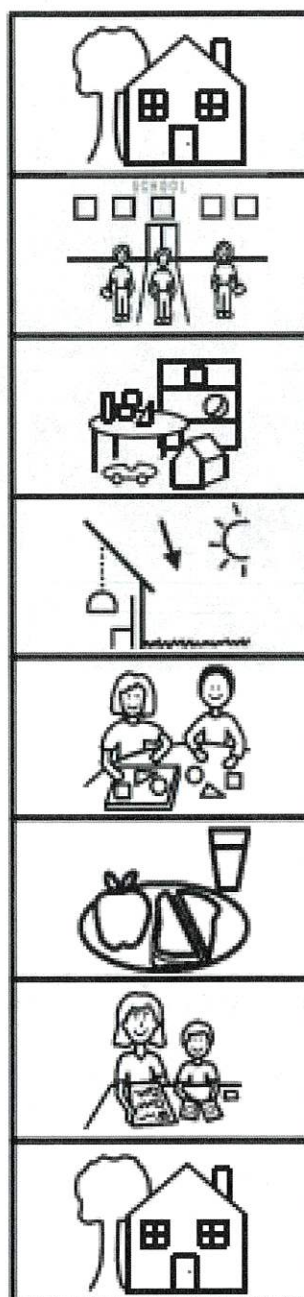


I can choose what I want for lunch each day (ideally with my parents and carers in advance).
