

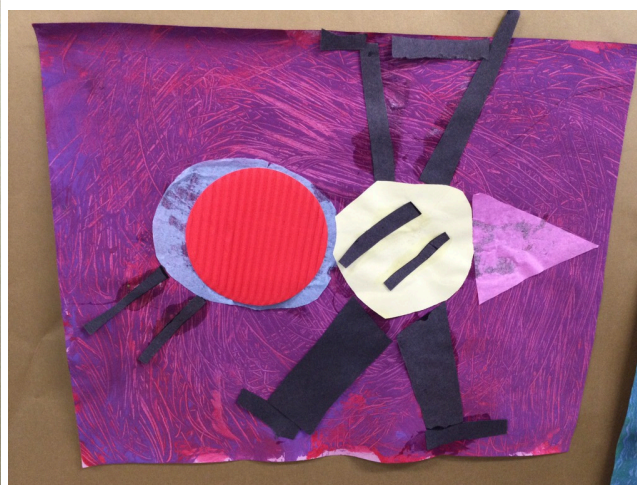

Hi Everyone,

Wow! We have had a busy few weeks!

W/B 17th June:

The children really enjoyed their visit to the Tea Tent and watching the Royal Procession. Thank you to all the parents that were able to help on the day. The children have been playing in our own Tea Tent in the outdoor area and designed and wrote about a cake that they would love to eat. During our Maths lessons the children practised adding and taking away. In RE we have started to learn about 'special places' and talked about our own home being special. In PSHE the children have been learning about friendships and what to do if they have a disagreement with someone. In our art lesson the children learnt about King Charles and drew a pencil drawing of the King in their art sketch book. We have been revising Phase 3 digraphs and trigraphs in our Phonics lessons.

W/B 24th June:

The children had a great time at Sports Day and were amazing completing all the activities but especially the relay. Well done Wren Class! This week saw the arrival of our caterpillars and they have been very hungry indeed! We read the story the 'Very Hungry Caterpillar' and the children sequenced the story as their Literacy task. During Phonics the children practised reading words that have two consonants together. We call these 'blends'. In our Maths lessons the children practised sharing and grouping objects.



W/B 1st July:

On Monday morning the children went to visit Miss Grigilis in Year 1. Although some of the children were a little anxious, they all returned happy and had enjoyed their visit. The children are now collecting their own lunch from the hatch and carrying it to their table. Just like the Year 1's! In our art lesson we explored how Eric Carle makes the beautiful pictures in his books and made our own collage pictures using a similar method. In Phonics we practised reading longer words and breaking them into two pieces to help read them. In our Literacy lesson we read the story 'The Bad Tempered Lady Bird' and wrote about an Eric Carle mini beast. In Our Maths lessons we revised numberbonds.

Next week we will be moving on from minibeasts and onto animals that we might find in the zoo!
