Hi Everyone,

I hope you all had a wonderful weekend in the sun!

Here is a quick summary of what we did last week...

In Phonics we have been practising reading and writing words that contain two digraphs/trigraphs such as 'chair'.

In our PSHE lesson, Mrs Day did a stand alone lesson on friendship and what is kind and not kind. We find that it is good to keep reminding the children so that they can support each other if they find they don't have anyone to play with, etc.



The children's bean plants have started to grow! The children are very excited about this! Some plants are growing faster than others so I have explained that some of the bean seeds are a little bit sleepy and need a bit longer to grow. I have plenty of seeds so we will keep trying! The children are keeping a bean diary and completed a page this week.

During our Literacy lesson we have been reading the story 'Who's in the Shed' about an unknown animal that is hidden in a farmyard shed. The children have to look for clues in the book to guess what animal it is. We then completed a drawing and writing task, where the children decided on animal hiding behind the shed door and wrote some clues about it.

In our RE lesson the children listened to a story from Asia called the 'Gold Giving Serpent' which talked about the moral of being greedy.

In Maths the children explored doubling and subtraction and completed activities to practise these along with continuing to practise their fluency with number bonds to 5.

In Forest School the children learnt about and made some clay hedgehogs.
