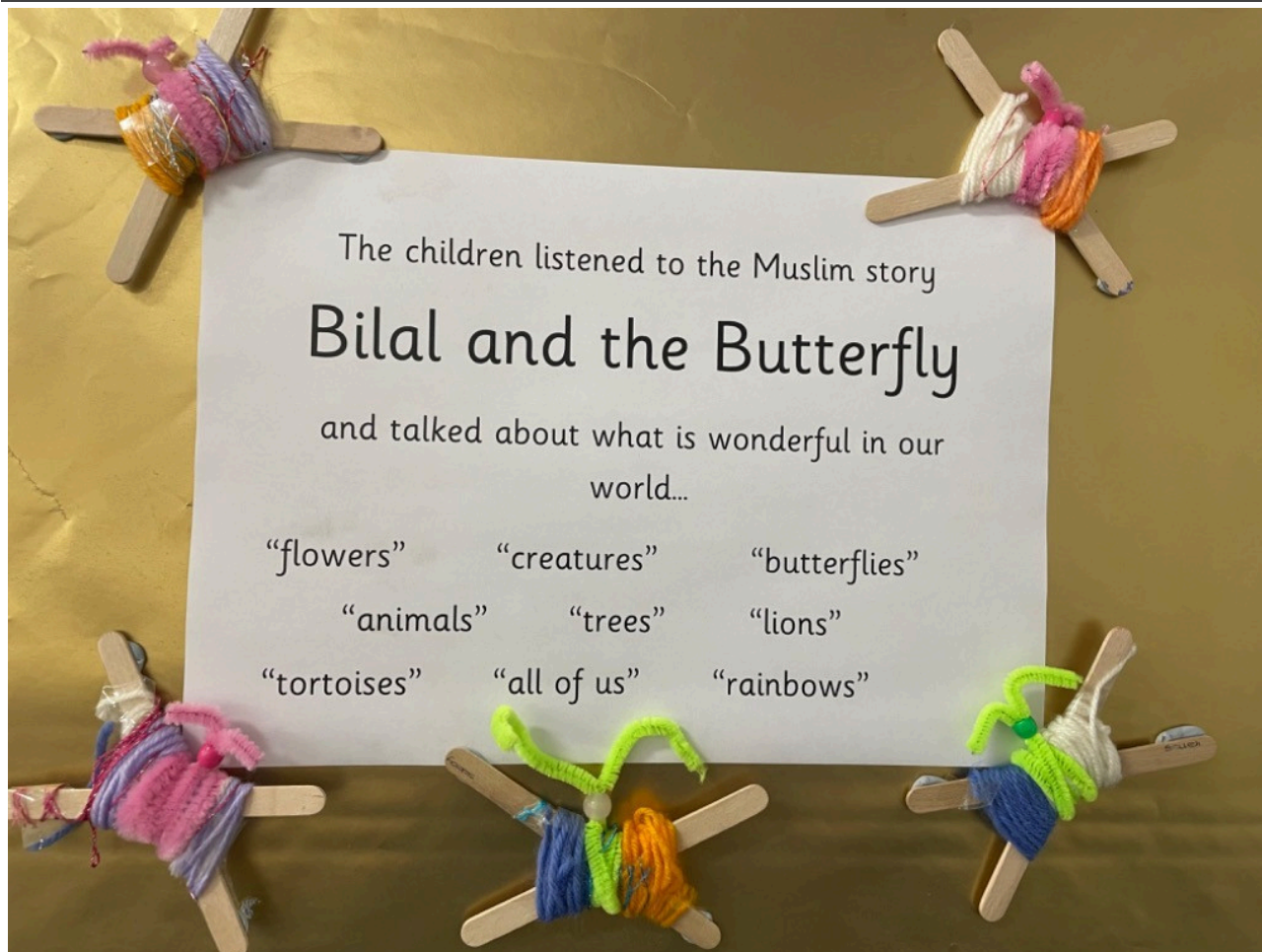

We have had a lovely week this week and the children are really beginning to settle into listening and learning and completing some work. I am very proud of how their reading and writing is progressing.

In our Phonics lessons we have continued to revise Phase 3 sounds and longer words, using the chunking method (breaking the words into sections).

In Literacy the children have written their own version of Jack and the Beanstalk by completing three pieces of writing, who or what was at the top of the beanstalk, what magical items they found and what happened to the giant?

In Maths we have practised making 10 and the different number bonds that make 10.



In RE the children listened to the story Bilal and the Butterfly (a Muslim story) about celebrating the wonderful things in our world. The children then told me their favourite wonderful thing in the world.

In PSHE the children learnt about the importance of sleep and talked about their bedroom routine.
