Hi Everyone,

A few updates from the last couple of weeks.

Phonics - we have started teaching Little Wandle Phonics again after revising digraphs and trigraphs for a few weeks. I have popped a copy of this weeks learning into the children's reading packs.

Reading - The children are making good progress in their reading ability. Please continue to read their school reading books as often as you can and read each book at least three times so that the children are confident and fluent at reading the words. It really does make a huge difference to children's progress and our best readers and writers are the children that read regularly at home.

Maths - we have been looking at numbers 6,7,8,9 and 10 over the last few weeks, exploring number bonds, one more and one less, addition, subtraction, odd and even numbers and doubling.



PE - we have started to prepare for Sports Day and will be doing this over the next few weeks. I have assessed the children's bike riding ability and will hopefully be able to fit some bike riding lessons into the week at some point.

RE - We have been listening to fables from around the world and discussed 'The Boy That Cried Wolf' and the Sikh story 'The Priest and the Crocodile'.

Literacy - We are reading the story 'Jack and the Beanstalk' and planted some bean seeds this week. The children will be keeping a diary and monitoring their beans progress. Next week we will complete some fictional writing about the story.

Forest School - This week the children collected blossom, daisies, dandelions and spring flowers from the forest and made a picture, ready to be pressed in a flower press. We will use these flowers to decorate posters for the tea tent.

Spanish - we have been learning a few different ways to greet each other in Spanish. We have learnt 'hello', 'good morning', 'good night' and 'how are you?'. We have a Spanish speaking girl starting next week so we will try and learn a little bit of Spanish each week.

There are a couple of changes to our routine for the next few weeks. I will now be having my PPA (Admin time) on Monday morning instead of Tuesday. The children will be looked after by Mrs Lopez, Mrs Higgins for PE and Mrs Lewis for Phonics.
