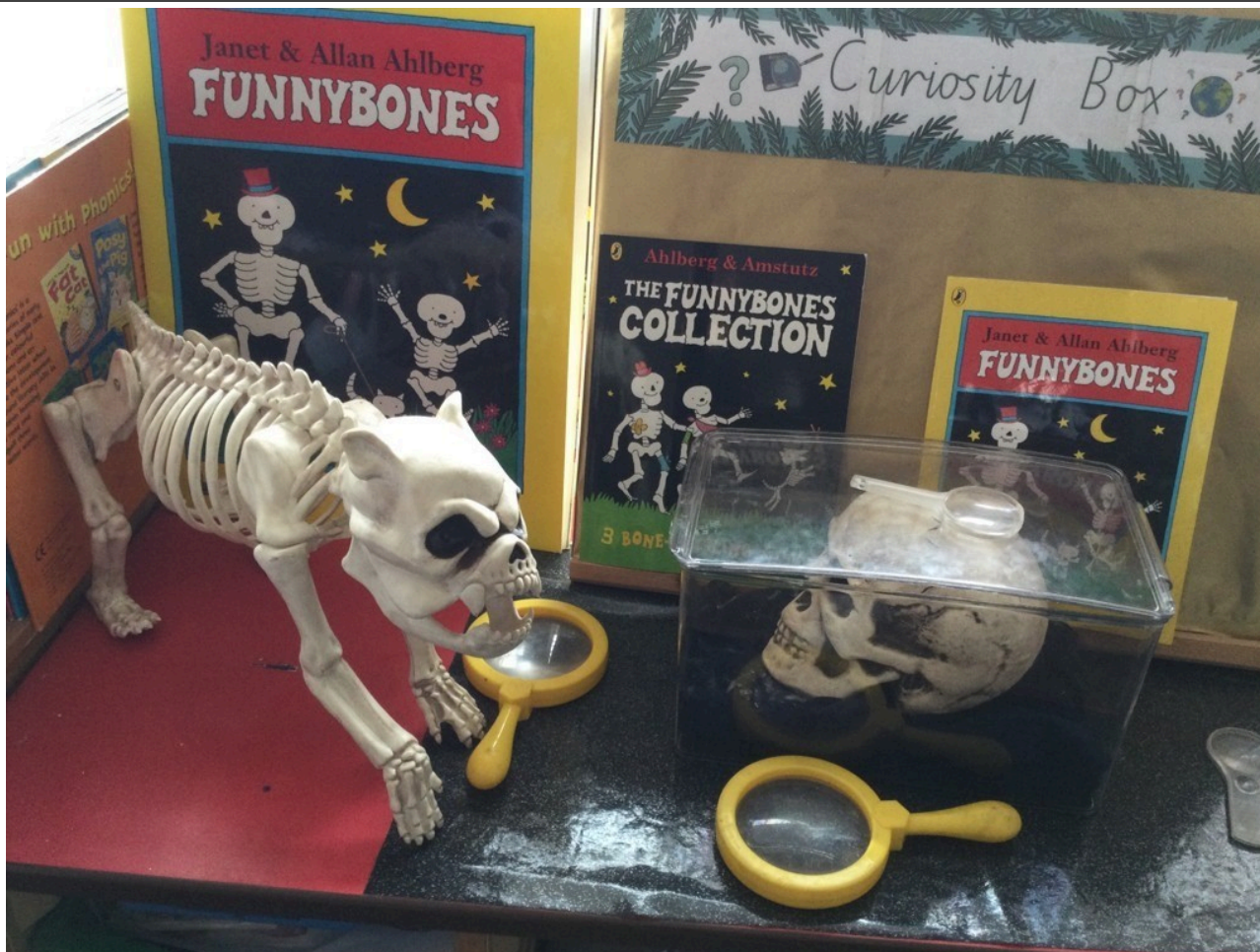

Hi Everyone,

Here is a summary of our first week back after half term.

The children enjoyed their first PE lesson with Mrs Higgins. Mrs Higgins showed the children how to warm up their bodies by playing the Bean Game, practised catching a bean bag by making their hands into a 'basket' and taking turns in races, moving their bodies in different ways. The children were very well behaved and listened carefully to Mrs Higgins' instructions.

In our Phonics lessons the children have been learning the phonemes 'ck' (digraph), 'e', 'u', 'r' and tricky word 'I'.



Our Literacy lesson has been based around the book 'Funnybones' and the children drew a picture of a skeleton of their choice and attempted writing initial sounds.

In our Maths lessons the children learnt and practised using vocabulary to describe size.

In RE we discussed why we receive presents and how it makes us feel when we receive one.

We have practised writing the letters that we have learnt this week in our handwriting lessons. The children have made great progress in their pencil control and are starting to form letters correctly and writing their name.

Forest School was a bit too wet and windy so instead Mrs Miles took the children onto the school field to splash in puddles and catch raindrops on the parachute. We then came back into the classroom and made flags before enjoying a biscuit and some milk.
