Hi Everyone,

I hope you have all had a lovely weekend in the sun!

Here is a summary of our learning in Wren Class last week.

We started our Phonics lessons this week! The children have been learning how to say the sounds made by the letters s,a,t and p. Please have a look at our class page for links to videos on how to correctly say these sounds as it isn't always as it seems! E.G. the letter 's' makes the sound ssssss not 's uh'. I have sent home a sheet summarizing our phonics learning for the week so that you can practise with your children.

In our Literacy lessons we have been reading the book 'Going on a Bear Hunt' and sequenced the story with actions. The children had a go at writing the initial sound of some of the words in the story such as 's' in squelch and 't' in tiptoe. They also drew a picture of what they thought might be inside the bears cave and came up with some great ideas.

On Tuesday the children discussed ideas about what 'kind hands' are and what is unkind. They drew around their kind hands and added their ideas to it.

In our handwriting lessons we have practised writing the letters s,t,a and p, starting at the top of each letter and saying the rhyme as we write it.



In our Forest School session the children took their teddy bears on a bear hunt in the forest. They swished through grass, splashed through water, stamped in mud and walked through pretend snow before discovering a bear in a cave shelter. The children explored the forest and had a go at bug hunting, playing in the mud kitchen and making leaf wreaths.

We also started our Maths lessons this week. We use the White Rose Scheme as a guide and started by learning to match and make sets. The children listen and watch a lesson and then put into practise what they have seen independently, using practical activities.

Finally, we ended the week by playing on the climbing frame and adventure trail with the Year 6 Buddies.
