This week we have been doing a little bit more 'work' and getting into a more structured routine, as well as starting our Dinosaur Topic!

On Monday we had a Phonics session. We listened to different sounds and tried to guess what the sounds were. We then read the story 'Harry & the Dinosaurs go to School' and had a go at drawing our own dinosaurs and making dinosaur masks. This was great to see which children can already use scissors. We have also been practising a Harvest Festival song, 'Harvest Samba'.

On Tuesday, the children had their Jigsaw Jenie PSHE lesson with Mrs Day and talked about different emotions and when they had felt them. In the afternoon we had a dough disco session to exercise our fingers and hands before practising controlling a pen and drawing on lines.

On Thursday the children went to Forest School. We spent a little bit of time in the classroom making flags by smashing leaves, petals and berries onto material with hammers.
