

## Forest School Sessions – Autumn Term 2025



Dear Parents,

The children in Year 2 will be having 3 blocks of Forest School across their time in Year 2. One in the Autumn term, one in the Spring and one in the Summer, these sessions will be on a Monday afternoon.

Please see below the dates your child will start and end each block:

Session 1 - Autumn Term: Monday 8<sup>th</sup> September - Monday 20<sup>th</sup> October 2025

Session 2 – Spring Term: Monday 12<sup>th</sup> January - Monday 9<sup>th</sup> February 2026

Session 3 – Summer Term: Monday 13<sup>th</sup> April - Monday 18<sup>th</sup> May 2026

The children will need to come to school dressed for forest school on these days. **They will not need to bring in their school uniform.**

They will need to wear the following PE kit items:

- **A pair of warm tracksuit bottoms or leggings, navy blue or black. The school PE tracksuit bottoms are ideal for this.**
- **The school PE jumper or zip up hoodie**
- **The school PE T-shirt**
- **A waterproof coat and waterproof trousers**
- **A pair of trainers (for wearing inside the classroom)**
- **A pair of either wellington boots or walking/snow boots that will be kept in school**
- **Warm socks, gloves and a hat as the weather gets colder**

We ask all parents to provide waterproof trousers for their own child if possible. These should be brought into school in a carrier bag on your child's forest school day and then taken home at the end of the day. Please could you ensure that these are named. We will allocate a small number of trousers to each class as spares, but we will not have enough for the whole class. Forest School sessions will go ahead in all weathers (including rain!), so we need children to have these waterproof trousers in school. We will only call off a session due to high winds, heavy rain, or storms!

Please ensure your child has the correct clothing in school ready for these sessions. The children will need to be in normal school uniform when not scheduled for a Forest School session.
