## **Year 6 Residential visit to Mill on the Brue Monday 16<sup>th</sup> June – Thursday 19<sup>th</sup> June 2025**

Dear Parents and Carers,

We are very much looking forward to taking Year 6 pupils to Mill on the Brue in June, before the end of their time at Cheapside School. Further details can be found at: <https://www.millonthebrue.co.uk/>  
The Children will be leaving on Monday morning and returning Thursday evening.

The inclusive cost for this trip, including coach transportation is £499.

Whilst we ask for voluntary contributions to cover the cost of the visit, without voluntary contributions to meet the full costs, visits like these cannot take place. We are therefore asking parents to commit to voluntary contributions of £499 with a deposit of £79.00 by 30<sup>th</sup> November 2024, along with the pro-forma, to reserve a place. Payments should be made via our online payment system (ScoPay). This has been set up to allow payment by instalments, you do not have to pay in one lump sum.

It is the Governors' belief that no child should be disadvantaged and any parent who is unable to commit to the voluntary contribution of £499 or would like to pay in installments that include the month of June, should see our bursar, Amanda Southby or myself in complete confidence.

### **Insurance**

Insurance is covered under the school's service level agreement with the Royal Borough of Windsor and Maidenhead and details are available on request. Please note that dentistry is not covered by our insurance.

### **Dentistry**

Please note that this is an activity holiday and, as dentistry is often not provided by the NHS, you may wish to take out private dental insurance which covers any accidental damage to teeth. For your information, RBWM's offsite activity policy covers the costs incurred for treatment due to injury resulting from an accident damaging the teeth up to £1000.

We very much hope that as many pupils as possible will attend as this is a valuable team building experience.
