Home School Agreement

In support of Covid-19 School Return Plan

School Staff will:

- Provide an environment which has been risk assessed in response to the Covid-19 infection.
- Remind children to wash hands frequently throughout the day for 20 seconds and to teach and encourage good respiratory hygiene practices – (coughing and sneezing into the inside elbow) and safe disposal of used tissues.
- Protect themselves and children by keeping a 2m distance where possible and appropriate.
- Remind children of the social distancing guidelines of 2m where appropriate.
- Clean surfaces, resources and frequently touched areas (light switches etc.) regularly throughout the day.
- Deep clean the school midweek (between Bubbles changing over).

Parents will:

- Share the expectations of children set out in the section below with their children before they return to school.
- Educate children in thorough and regular handwashing.
- Ensure their child attends in clean clothes (guidance is to wash daily).
- Arrive promptly at school at the allotted time for 'drop-off' and 'pick-up'. If late, please join the end of the queue, abiding by accepted social distancing practice and observing 2m gap at all times.
- ONLY enter the school site to 'drop-off' and 'pick-up' children as directed. In case of emergencies please contact the school office to make specific arrangements.
- Endeavour to follow official government guidance for **all** social interactions, in order to protect our staff and all the children within our setting.
- Monitor their child's temperature daily. Children who show signs of fever (temperature above 37.5 degrees) or other Covid-19 symptoms as listed on the NHS 111 site should not attend school and should be kept at home for the well-being of the Cheapside community and all staff.
- Ensure the whole family adheres to guidance for self-isolation if any family member exhibits symptoms of Covid-19 (14 days' isolation). In addition, seek testing as soon as possible and advise the school of the result.

Children will:

- Wash/sanitise their hands upon entry into school and throughout the day.
- Enter school with a snack, water bottle and possibly a packed lunch in a throw away bag only and put into their zipped wallet.
- Make sure they put rubbish firmly in the bin.
- Sit at their desks to work unless instructed by an adult to do another activity (Y1 to Y6).
- Try their best to stay socially distanced when possible.
- Try their best not to touch anyone else or anyone else's belongings.
