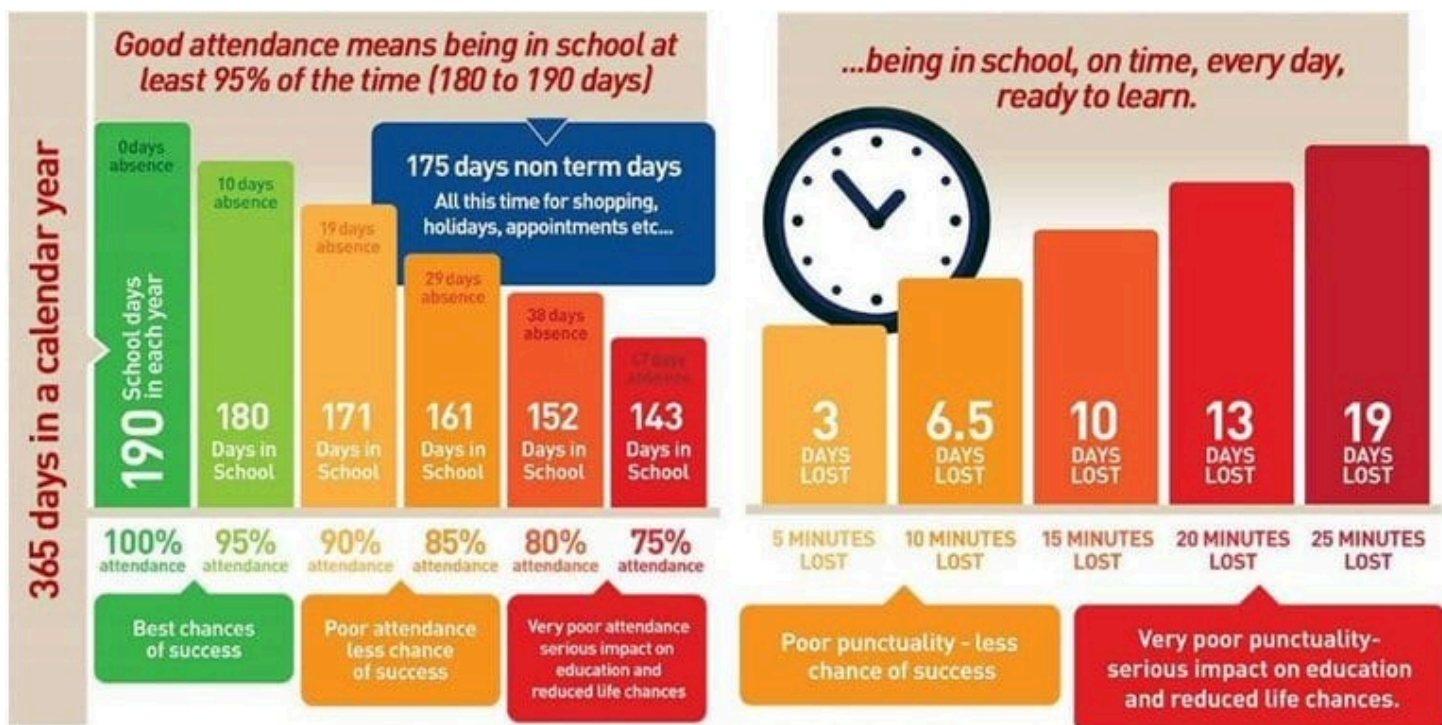
Attendance & Lateness

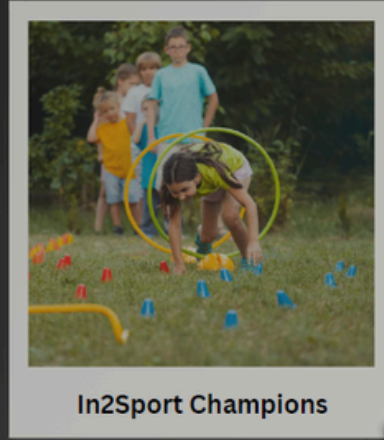
