I am delighted to share the outcome of our recent Statutory Inspection of Anglican and Methodist Schools (SIAMS), which took place on 20th May 2026. This inspection looks closely at how our Christian vision shapes daily life and enables everyone in our community to flourish.

Under the current SIAMS framework, the inspector, Jenny Earp, found that Cheapside “is living up to its foundation as a Church school and is enabling pupils and adults to flourish.” This is the strongest affirmation the framework offers, and it is a reflection of the culture we are building together.

None of this happens by chance. It is the result of the dedication of our staff, the wisdom and support of our governors, the partnership of our families, and, of course, our wonderful children, who bring our vision to life every single day. To everyone in our community: thank you and well done.

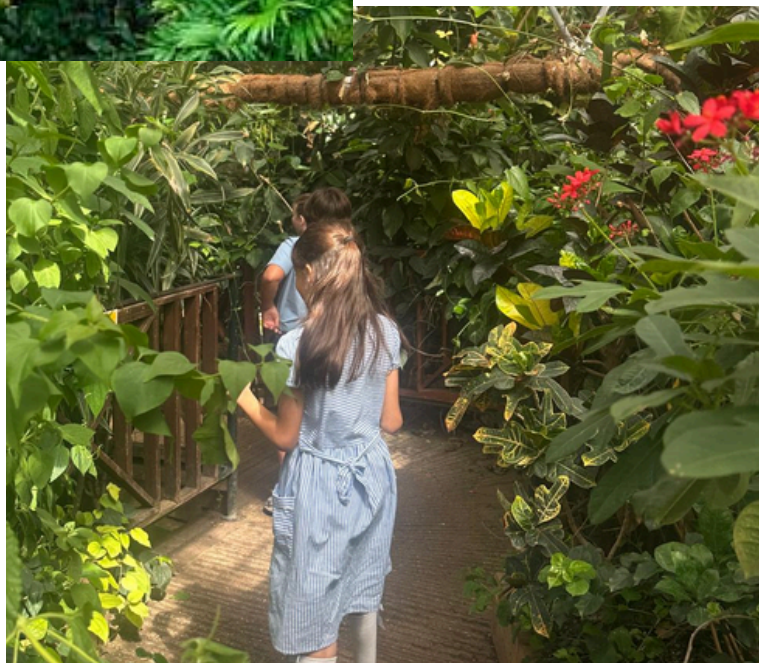

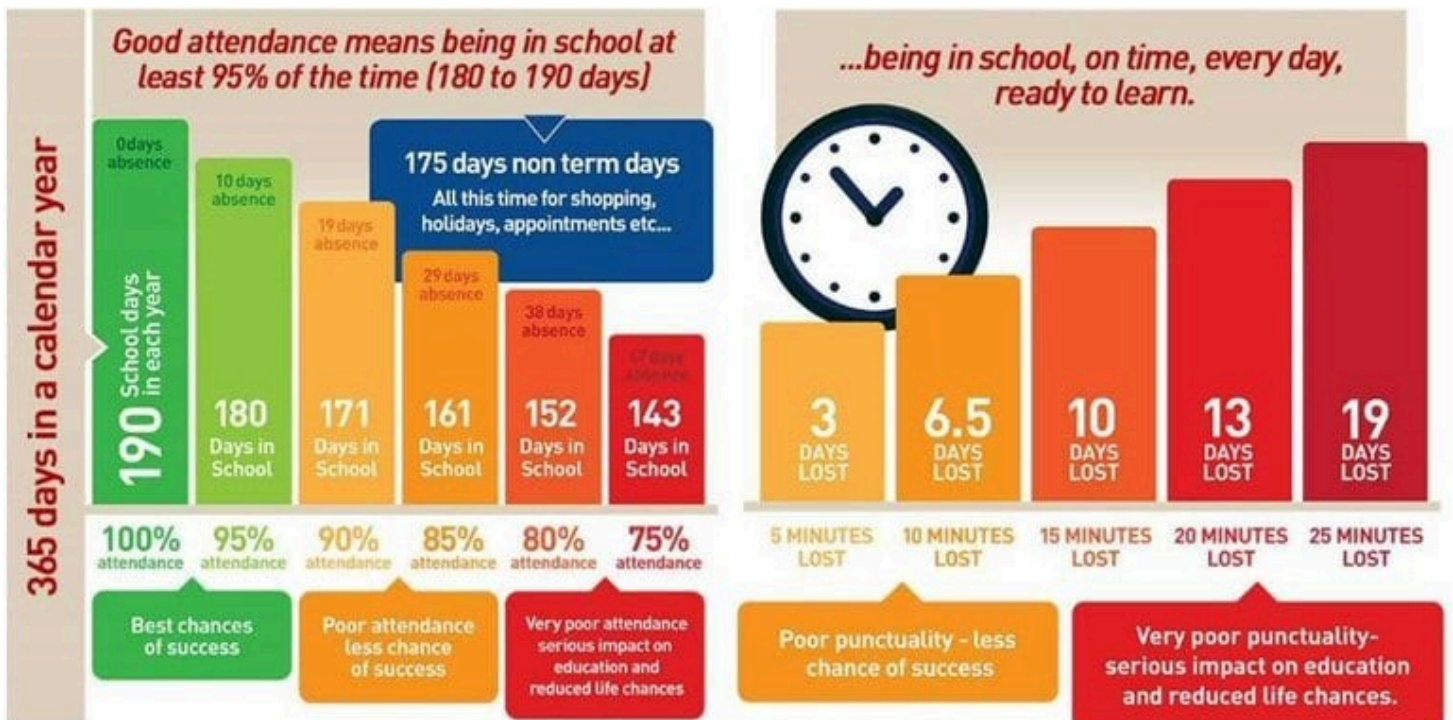
Attendance & Lateness

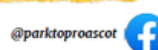

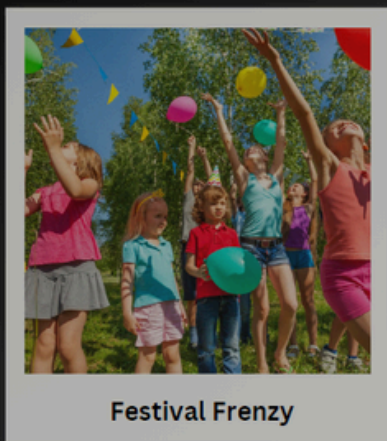

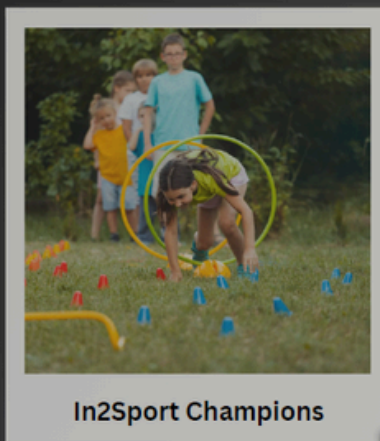
