Wrens have made some beautiful insect collages inspired by Eric Carle and his mini beast stories that we have been reading over the last few weeks.



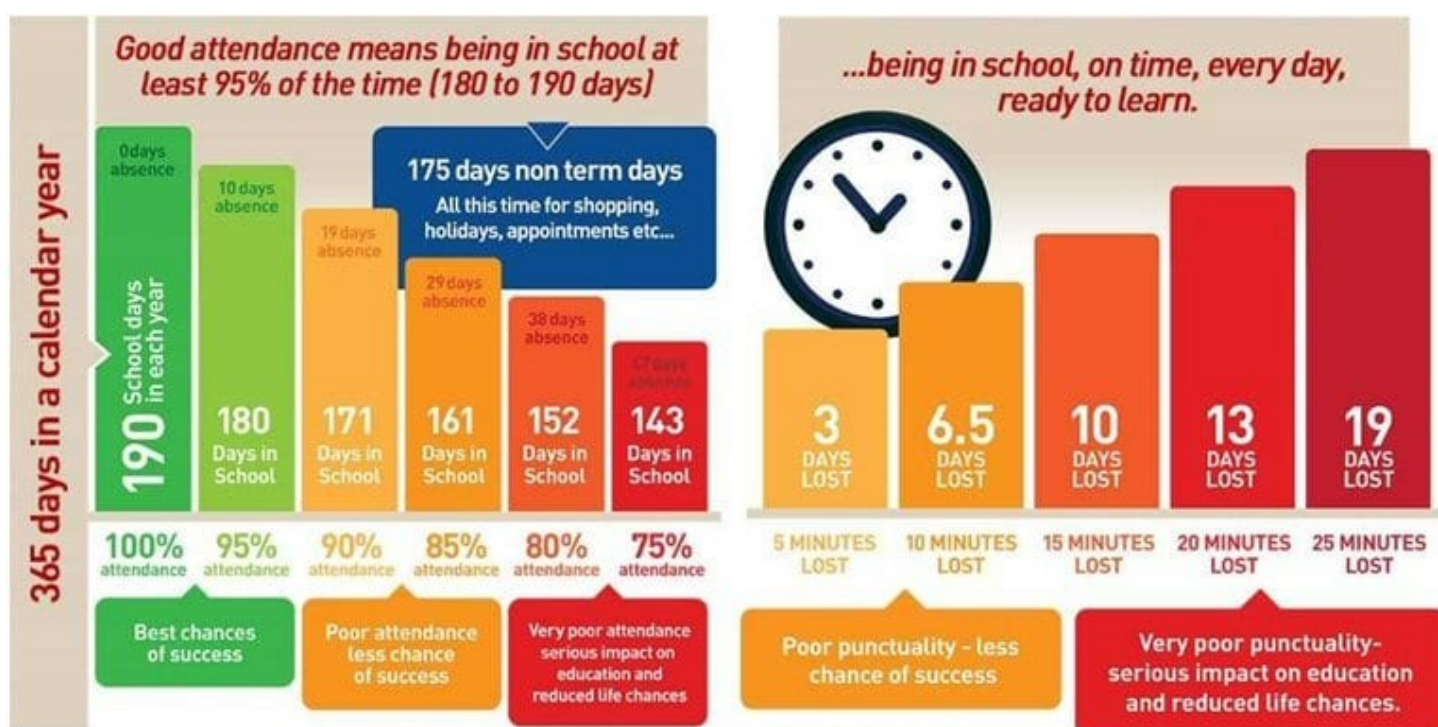
Attendance & Lateness

Children arriving after 08.50am are marked as late for registration which impacts their attendance record. Attendance is monitored by the Educational Welfare Officer from RBWM.

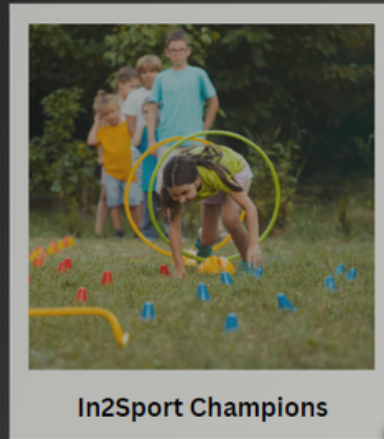
