<p><u>Maths</u> Our KIRF this term is to know the multiplication and division facts of the 2 times table. Please use lego bricks (or similar) to build a tower of between 1 and 10. Then repeat and count how many altogether ("double X is ?") Then build an even tower of 20 or less and half it ("half of ? is X). Try to remember without counting.</p>	<p><u>P.S.H.E.</u> Cut out the Zones of Regulation wheel and stick it up on the fridge at home. See if you can recognise where you feel you are on the wheel and have a chat to an adult at home and see where they think they are. You could also do it with your other family members.</p>	<p><u>R.E./English</u> After reading 'Wonderful Earth', 'George saved the world by lunchtime' and designing a superhero to help save the world at school. Please write a story or draw a cartoon to demonstrate how they will save/look after the Earth. Try to include lots of different adjectives.</p>	<p><u>Science</u> Create your own minibeast using a potato and things like toothpicks, googly eyes (if you have them) raisins, pens, any scrap materials you can use (with permission!) and then give your minibeast a name!</p>
